Bedford Square

As you enter the old Georgian square in Bloomsbury, London, the domestic façades facing east mask what lies behind – spaces of education, debate, innovation, play and experimentation, in which students and staff envision new forms of architectural practice. Generations of students and tutors have occupied these rooms with an attitude of appropriation, transforming the spaces through events, models, experiments, drawings, projections and multi-use programmes that take the domestic heritage and charm of the buildings as a backdrop.

The plans shown in this guide provide a map of how to navigate from space to space and floor to floor.




Disability access for entrances and exits around the AA School is indicated in each Floor Plan level. Please contact Reception for assistance in navigating school grounds.







Montague Street

In addition to our premises on Bedford Square, the AA also occupies two additional Georgian buildings at 1 and 1A Montague Street, which house both academic programmes and administrative departments. Just off the southern corner of Russell Square and adjacent to the British Museum, these buildings are a seven-minute walk from 36 Bedford Square.



Hooke Park


Hooke Park is a 150-hectare working forest that is owned and operated by the school, and contains a growing educational facility for design, workshop, construction and landscape-focused activities. Located in the county of Dorset, England, it has been designated an Ancient Woodland and forms part of the Dorset Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The woodland is a mixture of broadleaved and conifer species that provide the prime source of timber for students' construction activities. The campus is home to the AA's Design and Make Taught Postgraduate programme and hosts many of the school's units and programmes throughout the year.

The plans in this guide provide a localised map for these campus buildings, but we encourage all who visit to venture beyond this immediate vicinity and feel free to explore the forest.






Hooke Park
